BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Dr. Michael Eisenberg's expertise is in use of information and technology literacy, information management in learning and teaching, and school library and information programs, K-12. Professor Eisenberg has an MLS from the State University of New York at Albany (1973) and a PhD in Information Transfer from Syracuse University (1986). He joined the UW Graduate School of Library and Information Science as Director in August 1998. He stepped down as Dean of the renamed iSchool in December 2005, and currently (2009) holds the position of Dean Emeritus and Professor while teaching at the UW iSchool.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The files in this collection have been specifically selected as those related to one of two subjects appropriate for inclusion in a larger collection with information about multiple iSchools:

- · The creation of the iSchool at the UW
- The relationship of the UW iSchool to other iSchools

Included are correspondence files which detail the offer made to Mike Eisenberg by UW Provost Lee Huntsman, as well as the text of speeches, talks, and letters circulated to students. Administrative files on the accreditation of the iSchool are also included, as are files on the school's name change. There are administrative reports and press releases, and photos taken of Mary Gates Hall during renovations made for the iSchool. There are notes taken by Michael Eisenberg during meetings with other deans at other iSchools. Finally, there are the letters and formal resignation of Mike Eisenberg as Dean.

All of these files are supplied in their original format, almost exclusively as Microsoft Office files. At the time of the writing of this finding aid, all were readily openable by Office 2007 programs.
